



Covid-19 Classroom Protocol

In-person, classroom instruction and participation is critically important for our students. While we continue to monitor the progression of COVID-19 and measures to reduce/eliminate its spread, we will be implementing these procedures to increase the safety and health of our students and instructors.

1. Prior to arriving at class, each student must perform a temperature check. If the temperature registers above 100 degrees, the student must stay home.
2. Masks or face shields must be appropriately worn by students and instructors (mouth and nose covered). Please contact us if accommodations are necessary.
3. We will be practicing physical distancing (no shaking hands, elbow-bumping, fist-bumping, etc.).
4. Prior to entering the classroom, each student must either wash his/her hands for 20 seconds or utilize hand sanitizer. NTC will make every attempt to provide hand sanitizer at the door and throughout class, but each student is encouraged to carry a personal supply that contains AT LEAST 60% isopropyl alcohol.
5. Tabletops will be cleaned prior to the commencement of class and prior to our departure.
6. Students will not share writing utensils, paper, books, or any other personal belongings or NTC-supplied materials.
7. Any materials distributed to the students will not be passed between students.
8. Currently, travel within the United States does not require quarantine/self-isolation unless symptoms appear. If a student travels outside the United States, there is a mandatory 14-day quarantine period that begins immediately upon return to the United States.
9. If a student or instructor tests positive for COVID-19, class participation must cease for at least ten days or three days post-symptoms, whichever is longer. In the event an instructor tests positive, class will continue in an online format (as the instructor is able) during the quarantine period until classroom instruction can resume.
